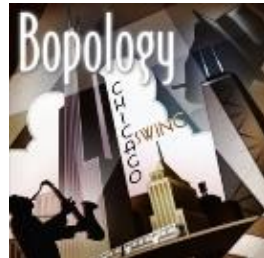
**Thursday 11/21

Their musical time period: a 1950's and 1960's sound delivered through an immersion in Modern Swing. Bopology recreates the swing revival of 1998 – 2002 with music from the movie "The Mask" (1996 Warner Bros. Jim Carey) along with jazz standards and jump blues.
